

Dr. Venkat Allada is a Professor of Engineering Management & Systems Engineering at Missouri S&T. Effective Jan. 1, 2018, he now serves as special advisor to the provost to help ensure a smooth transition as the office of graduate studies merges with Missouri S&T's office of research and sponsored programs. For over a decade until December 2017, he served as Missouri S&T's first and only vice provost of graduate studies where he significantly raised the university's graduate education profile by increasing recruitment and retention of high-quality doctoral students, earning high levels of student satisfaction for services provided by the office of graduate studies, attaining record enrollments of doctoral students, and creating new professional development opportunities for graduate students.

He serves as the 2017-18 past chair of the Mid-west Association of Graduate Schools (MAGS). Dr. Allada earned his doctoral degree in Industrial Engineering from University of Cincinnati in 1994. His teaching and research interests are in areas of STEM education, lean thinking, design automation, and sustainable product design. He is recipient of the 1998 ASEE Dow Outstanding New Faculty Award, 1998 Outstanding Young Manufacturing Engineer Award by the Society of Manufacturing Engineers, and 2005 Outstanding Contributions Award by MIT's Lean Aerospace Initiative. He is the recipient of several Missouri S&T Faculty Excellence Awards, Outstanding Teaching Award of Excellence, and Innovative Teaching Award. He has over 100 publications in refereed journals and conference proceedings.
