GPA calculations on graduate transfer grades (from last meeting)

- Graduate Catalog:
 - 3.0 GPA for graduate work at S&T
 - 3.0 GPA over the plan of study
- Long term Practice at S&T:
 - 3.0 GPA (cumulative including any transfer hours approved on the plan of study)
