GLO Project Update

- Documents requested from departments
 - List of outcomes for each program
 - Mapping of program outcomes to graduate outcomes (knowledge, critical thinking, effective communication, professional development)
 - Mapping of program outcomes to assessment activities (e.g., thesis defense, dissertation defense)
 - Rubric for each assessment activity

GLO Project Update

- Progress since 9-17 CGCS Meeting:
 - Formal GLO statements drafted (see next slide)
 - Outcomes, mappings, and rubrics received from several departments
 - Several departments are at various stages of completion by Oct 30

GLO Project Update

- Proposed Campus GLO Statements

- *Knowledge:* Students will be able to demonstrate advanced knowledge of subject matter within their discipline.
- *Communication:* Students will be able to demonstrate effective communication within their discipline.
- *Critical thinking:* Students will be able to demonstrate productive critical thinking within their discipline.
- *Professional development:* Students will be able to demonstrate professionalism within their discipline

 - 6 of the 8 enrolled

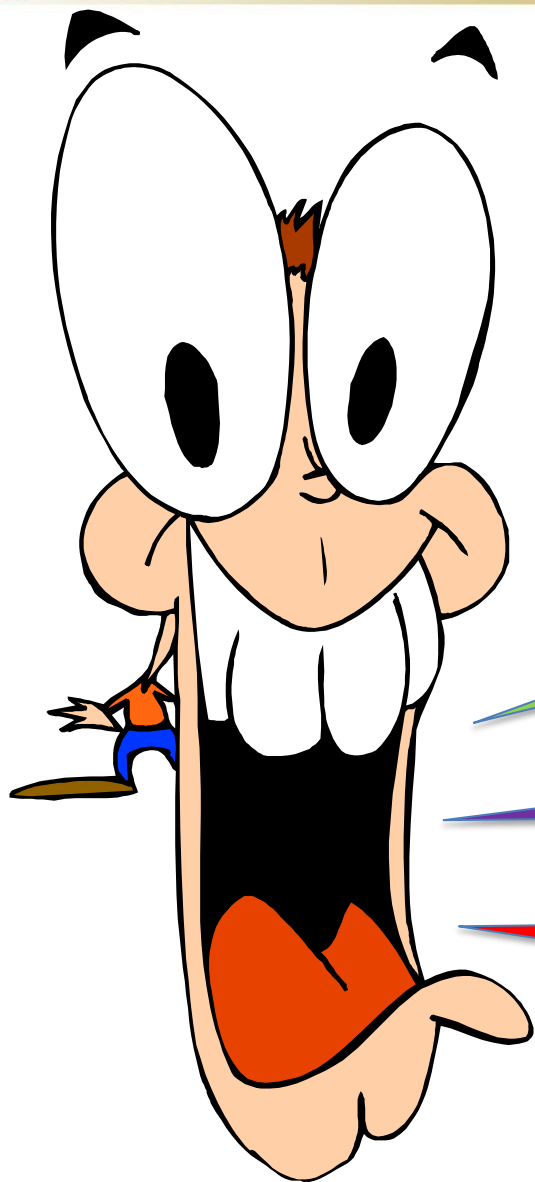
GradStaff Q&A
