Reallocation Process

- After March 15, unclaimed CF's will revert to the Office of Graduate Studies to be reallocated
- We will continue to consider only PhD applications until May 15 on a first-come, firstserved basis.
- MS Applications will be considered after May 15, 2009.
- Equity between programs will be maintained

Causes of delay in processing CF applications

- Missing or incomplete information
- No department signature indicating approval
- Missing transcripts and/or S&T graduate application
- Student not eligible (criteria not met)
- No departmental ranking

Image Now


UM System has a contract with Image Now

 Would allow us to scan documents for electronic retrieval and storage




Process Before Imaging
