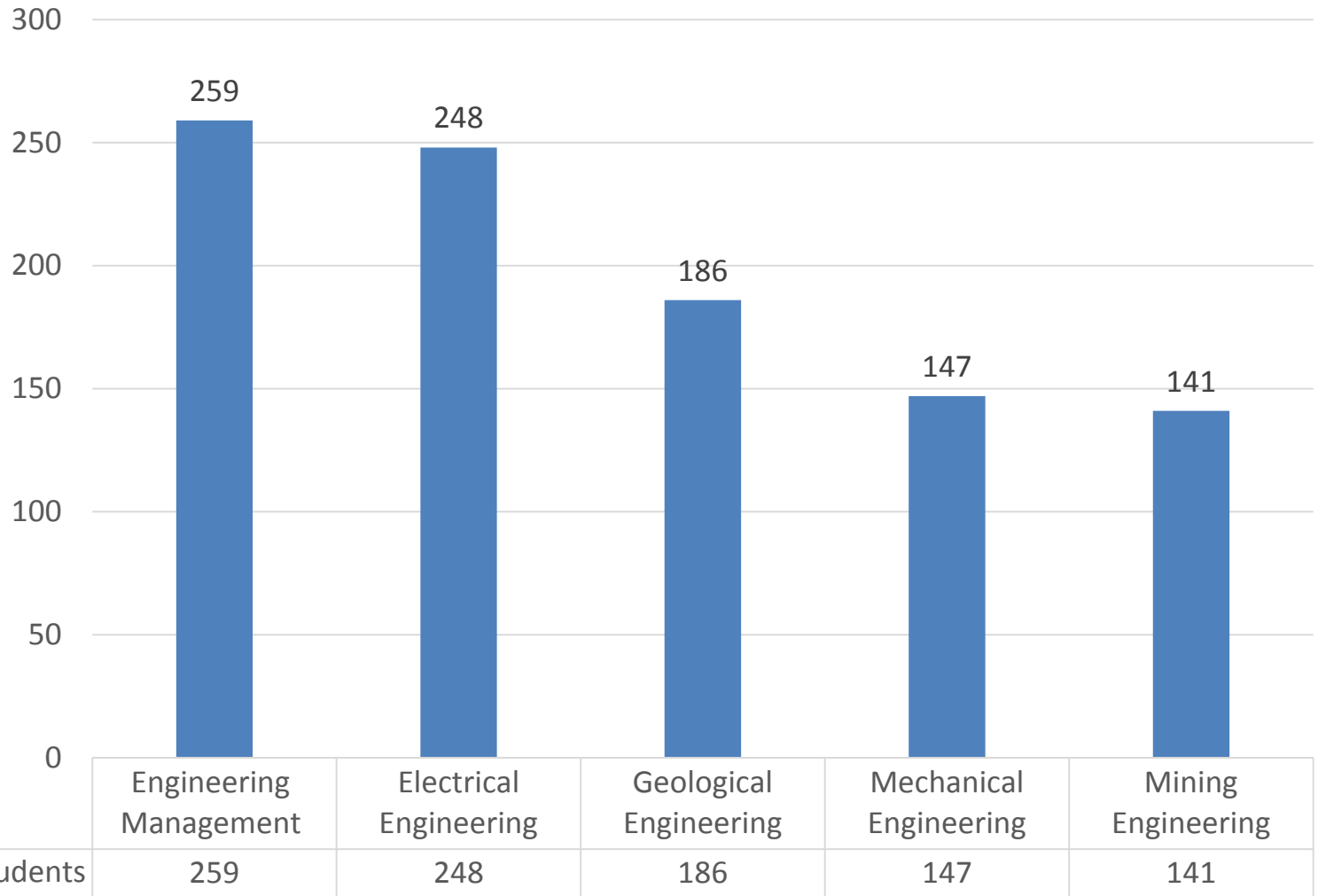

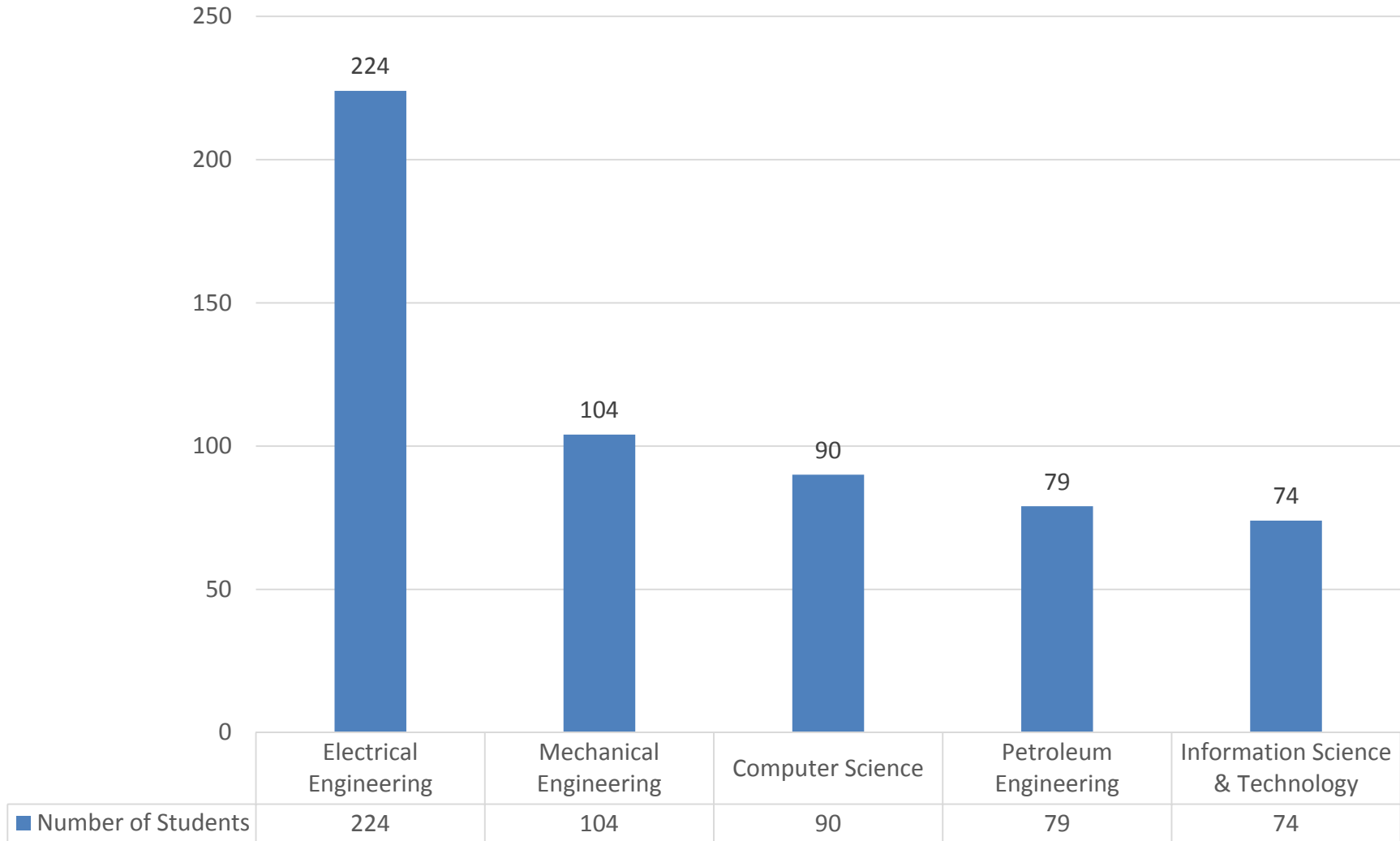
# Graduate Enrollment FS 14: Top Five



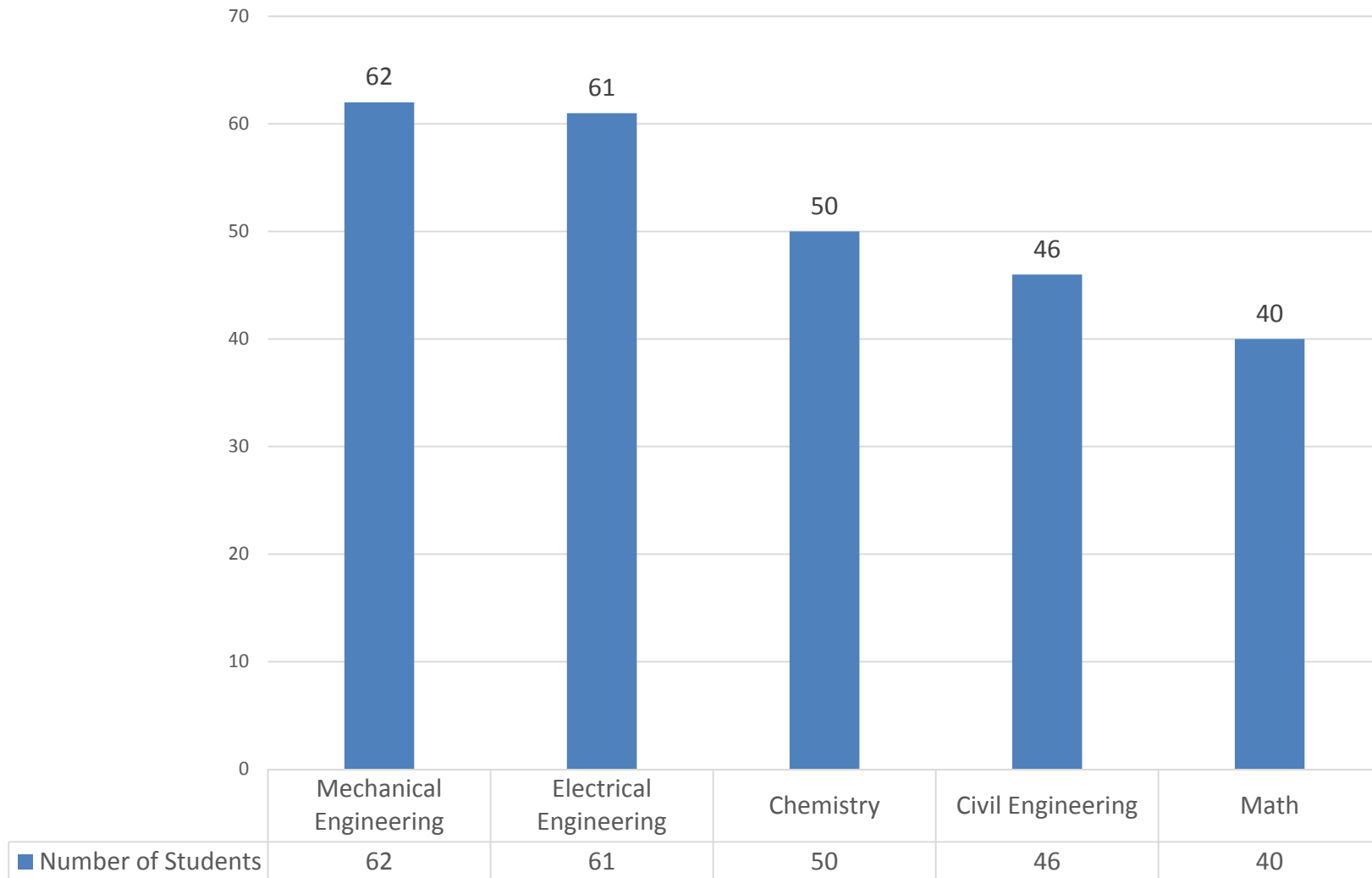

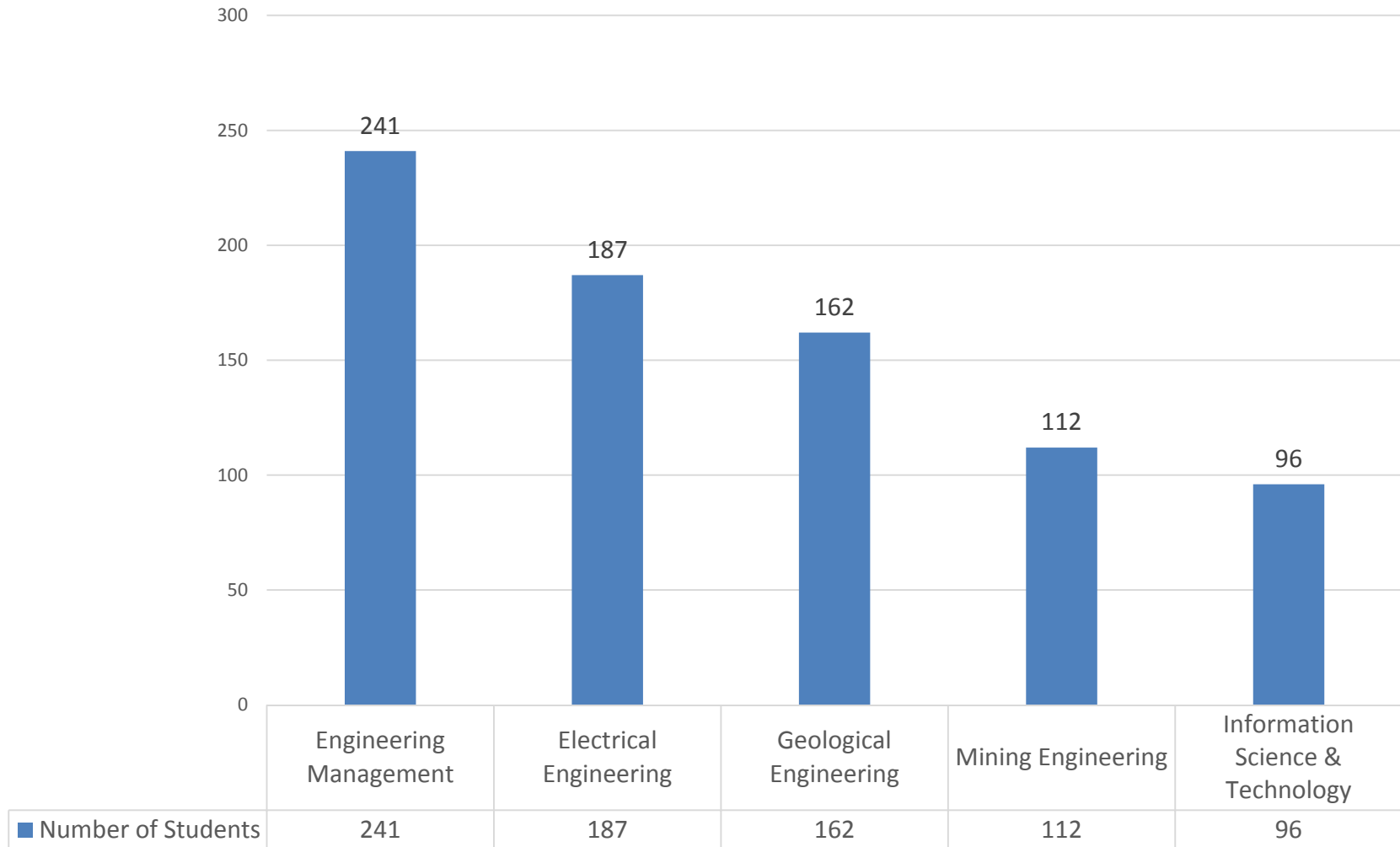
# Grad On Campus Enrollment: Top Five



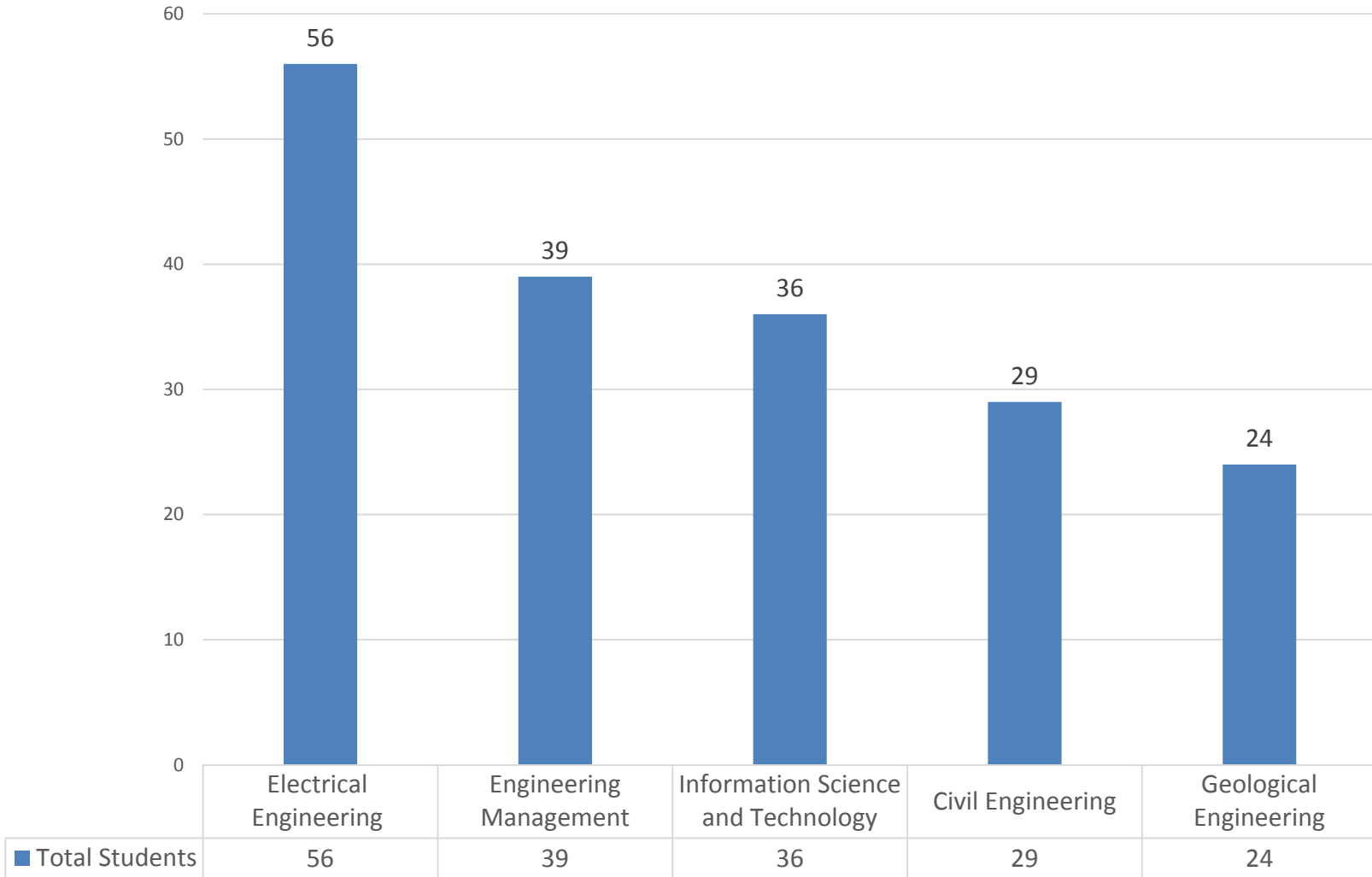
# PhD Enrollment: Top Five



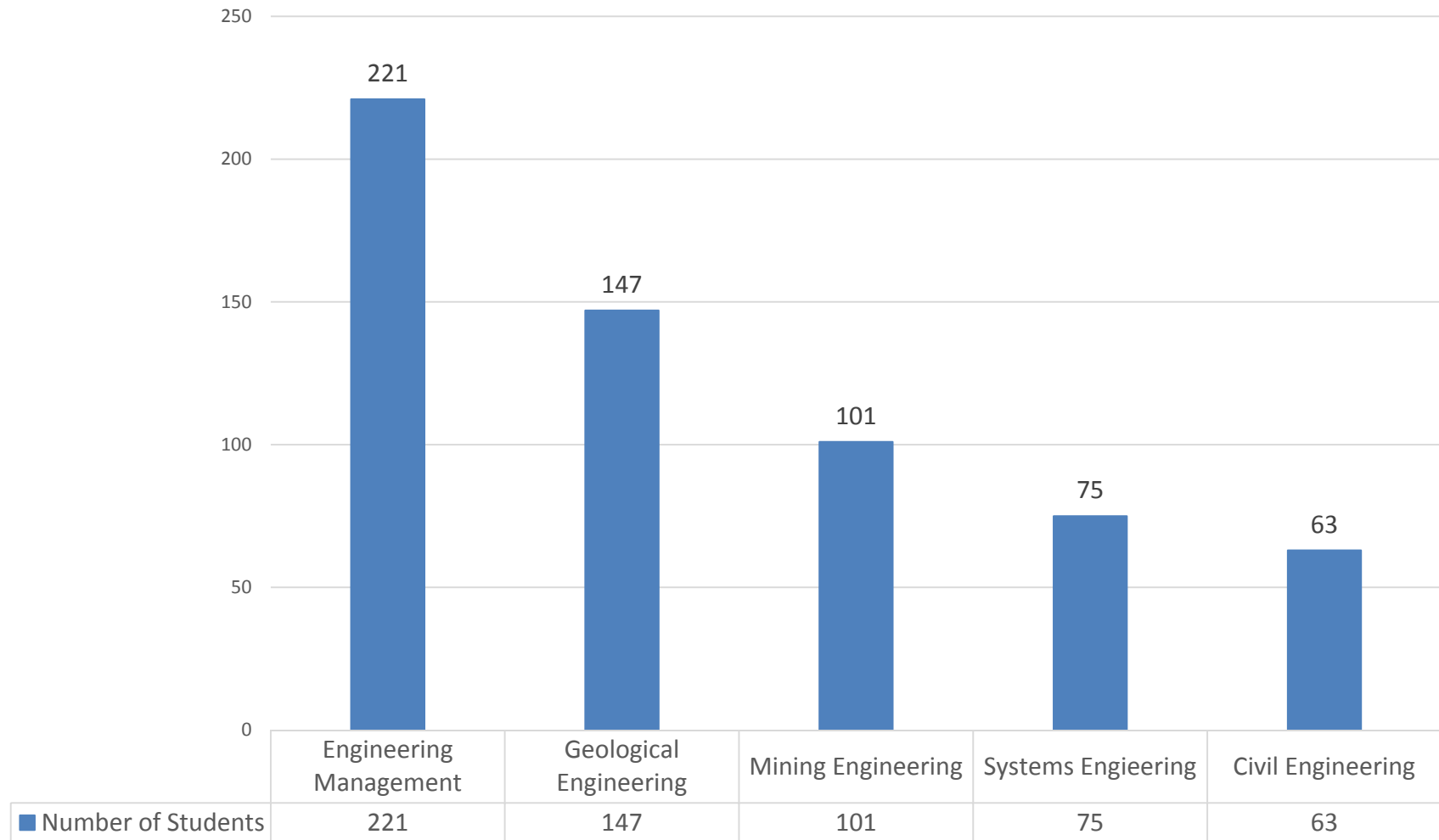
# MS Enrollment: Top Five
