## **Graduate Catalog Update**

- Graduate Catalog changes were approved at the March 18<sup>th</sup> Graduate Council meeting
- Second round of edits to the Graduate Catalog will be due the beginning of May
- Another revision of Form 1/1A will be coming after voted on and approved by Graduate Faculty (continue to use the form on the website until the revised one is approved)



### **Slate Update**

- Chancellor's Distinguished Fellowship, Experience S&T, and Dissertation Completion Fellowship applications are live.
- The awaiting submission bin has been removed, this mirrors the information that was available in PeopleSoft. Students who are awaiting submission are contacted regularly by the Office of Graduate Studies to ask if they have questions or need help completing their application.
  - This was due to the chance of a breach in student rights; students are not considered valid applicants until they hit the submit button.
  - This information is not lost, just viewable in a different format
