Quality of research	
Consider the following:	
<ul> <li>Are there clear objectives, methods, results, and conclusions?</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Are conclusions well-reasoned and supported by results?</li> </ul>	/40
<ul> <li>If results are pending, is there evidence of progress toward</li> </ul>	,
objective and preparation to interpret results?	
Merit of research	
Consider the following:	
<ul> <li>Does the research have apparent real-world applications?</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Is the research presented in a coherent context of academic</li> </ul>	/15
literature, previous studies, etc.?	
<ul> <li>Are the broader impacts of the work given?</li> </ul>	
Visual presentation	
Consider the following:	
<ul> <li>Are the slides well-organized? Visually appealing?</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Is there a thoughtful and effective balance of figures and text?</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Do the figures enhance understanding of the research?</li> </ul>	/15
<ul> <li>Are figures presented with all information necessary to interpret</li> </ul>	
them (axis labels, legends, captions, etc.)?	
Oral presentation	
Consider the following:	
<ul> <li>Does the presenter come across as a professional? As an expert</li> </ul>	/30
(commensurate with their level of experience) in their subject	/30
matter?	
<ul> <li>Are the tone and pace of the presentation appropriate?</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Does the presenter respond appropriately to relevant questions</li> </ul>	
about the research?
